- Global Genius Hall of Fame member, World Music Master Open and six-time Global Music Award winner Rodrigo Landa-Romero is an 18-year-old Mexican global performer, composer, concertizing pianist, orchestrator, arranger, producer, filmmaker, and entrepreneur who began his music and artistic life at age two. Named one of the World's Top 100 Child Prodigies 2022, (Dubai).

 - ✓ Has released 9 albums and 3 singles (orchestral 47%, piano solo 40%, Chamber 13%, allocated by a total of 5 hours of music), all his own compositions.
